Beached bird surveys, June - August 1992

Few surveys were conducted, as usual during summer. The only information received came from Texel and Ameland, where a mixture of species was found, including Cormorants, Eider, Shelduck and the commoner species of gulls. Very few birds were oiled and one Herring Gull was found entangled in nylon thread.
