Replacement name for, and note on, Denticulabrum Vermeij, 1999 (Gastropoda, Buccinidae)

Accidenticulabrum nom. nov. is a replacement name for Denticulabrum Vermeij 1999, non Sohl, 1998.

P. Bouchet (personal communication, January, 2000) has pointed out to me that *Denticulabrum* Vermeij, 1999 (p. 186) is preoccupied by *Denticulabrum* Sohl, 1998 (p. 64), a genus of Cretaceous trochid gastropods from Jamaica. Here I rename my genus as **Accidenticulabrum** nom. nov.

In my original paper, I had overlooked Vredenburg's (1922) assignment of the type species of *Accidenticulabrum*, *Fusus sangiranensis* Martin, 1906, to *Lacinia* Conrad, 1853. The Eocene genus *Lacinia* differs from *Accidenticulabrum* by having an indeterminate, adapically deeply notched outer lip instead of an externally thickened, adapically extended but unnotched terminal adult varix, and by lacking a basal labral tooth. *Accidenticulabrum* appears to be a phosine buccinid, whereas *Lacinia* may belong to the Melongenidae.
