Carex × *terschellingensis* hybr. nov. [= *Carex acuta* × *C. trinervis*] and *Carex* × *reichgeltii* hybr. nov. [= *Carex acuta* × *C. aquatilis*], Cyperaceae, found in the Netherlands – Rectification

In [Koopman et al.'s \(2021\)](#) Appendix on page 34, in the right column, three collections of *Carex* × *reichgeltii* Jac.Koopman, Więclaw & Waltje (*Carex acuta* L. × *C. aquatilis* Wahlenb.) are mentioned for Germany, all kept in B (Berlin). However, the first two – the one from ditches in woods near Nuremberg, Bavaria (Nürnberg, Bayern), and the one from Grossenhain, Saxony (Sachsen) – must be deleted from the list. The specimens of these two collections are probably hybrids of *C. acuta*, but not from a crossing with *C. aquatilis* as the other parent, because this species only occurs in Lower Saxony (Niedersachsen) in the northwest of Germany, and neither in Bavaria nor in Saxony in the southeast.

So, the hybrid *Carex* × *reichgeltii* does occur in Germany, but only in Lower Saxony, where the third collection comes from.
