The FIRST EUROPEAN SYMPOSIUM ON ODONATOLOGY will be held at the Institute of Zoology (Instituut voor Dierkunde) of the University of Gent, Belgium, on Friday 22nd and Saturday 23rd October, 1971.

The meeting is open to all workers in the field of Odonatology, and will start on Friday morning October 22nd, at 10.00 a.m.

Sessions will be devoted to general discussions on organizational matters and, more in general, are meant to provide an opportunity for odonatologists to get acquainted and discuss problems with colleagues from different countries. Plans for the foundation of a "EUROPEAN ODONATOLOGICAL UNION" will be considered.

Papers (20 minutes) will be read on various topics in the field of dragonfly research. Abstracts (1 page in English, French, German or Dutch) will be distributed together with the second circular, provided the manuscripts will have reached the Organizing Committee by September 1st, 1971.

There will be no registration fee. Hotel reservations can be made through the Organizing Committee (single room approx. Bfr. 300-350 per night).

During the meeting meals can be obtained at moderate prices in the vicinity of the Institute. One common dinner is being planned (approx. Bfr. 200-300).
