

SECOND INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM OF ODONATOLOGY

Advanced Announcement

The Second International Symposium of Odonatology will be held during three days at the end of September or at the beginning of October, 1973, at Karlsruhe, German Federal Republic. The international odonatological society, S.I.O., extends to odonatologists and dragonfly admirors throughout the world a cordial invitation to join together for the Symposium. The Program Committee hopes to arrange a number of colloquia on topics of current importance.

The Symposium will meet at the State Museum of Natural History (Landessammlungen für Naturkunde) of Karlsruhe, within easy reach of the magnificent Black Forest and the Upper Rhine Valley, where the autumnal dragonflies can still be collected while the meeting will be taking place.

The town of Karlsruhe lies at a distance of some 12 kilometers from the French border in the German State of Baden. It is rich in scientific and cultural institutions and in historical monuments of general interest. The nearby ancient town of Heidelberg is one of the most famous University and historical sites of Germany.

The second announcement will be sent out later in the season to all odonatologists known to the Organizing Committee and will contain further details on the program, registration and abstract forms, information on the usual weather, excursions etc. Among the latter one is planned to southern Europe.

We hope that odonatologists from around the world will join with us to discuss the many problems of interest to all of us.
