Abstract – The titles and addresses are listed of 60 odonatological journals, newsletters and other serial works, published currently (January 1995) by the International Odonatological Society (S.I.O.) and by 29 regional, national and local odonatological associations in 20 countries.

Introduction

The below is a list of 60 odonatological periodicals and serials in-print, published currently by the International Odonatological Society (S.I.O.) and by 29 regional, national and local odonatological associations in 20 countries and which were in evidence with the S.I.O. Central Office on January 1, 1995. After the respective title, the year of publication of the first issue is stated in brackets. The periodicals, the publication of which is known to have ceased, are omitted. Although some titles have not been published since several years, they are included if no formal notification on their suspension has been received.

All S.I.O. periodicals can be ordered through the S.I.O. Central Office in Bilthoven, The Netherlands. The current addresses of all others are stated.

“Tombo Dokokai” (= Dragonfly Lovers’ Association) was the first formal odonatological organisation on record (Nagoya, Japan, 1956). The Society of Odonatology, Tokyo and its periodical, *Tombo – Acta odonatologica* (1958), are the oldest organisation/journal in existence/in-print.
