THE 5th SOUTH ASIAN SYMPOSIUM OF ODONATOLOGY, Nagpur, India; 20-21 December 1998: A REPORT

The 5th South Asian Symposium of Odonatology was organized on 20-21 December 1998, by the SIO Regional South Asia Council and the Shri Shivaji Science College, Nagpur, in the framework of Dr Panjabrao Deshmukh Birth Centenary and the Nagpur University Platinum Jubilee celebrations. It took place in Dr Penjabrao Deshmukh Memorial Hall, Congress Nagar, Nagpur, India.

The Inaugural Function was held on 20 December. Honorable Shri Anil D e s h m u k h, State Minister of Education and Cultural Affairs, was the Chief Guest, and Shri M.S., *alias* Balasaheb S a p k a l, Vice President of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati, presided the Session. Drs A.S. S a t p u t a l e y (Chairman of the Nagpur University Platinum Jubilee Organizing Committee) and V.K. T h a k a r e (Emeritus Professor and former Head of the Post-Graduate Department of Zoology, Nagpur) were the Guests of Honour.

Shri Anil Deshmukh inaugurated the Symposium by lightening the lamp, and Dr A.S. Satputaley presented the "Symposium Souvenir". N.S. In the closing Session, Dr D.B. T e m b h a r e expressed on behalf of the Organizing Committee their gratitude to the Principal of Shri Shivaji Science College for the kind patronage. Dr T.M. K a r-d e, presented the *Professor S.N. Prasad Memo-rial Medal* to Mrs Kaplana A. K a l a s k a r, a young Symposium participant, for the best oral presentation, and to an undergraduate and a post-graduate student the award for the best presentation in the Symposium Exhibit.

Last but not least, the participants passed a warm motion of thanks to Dr R.J. A n d r e w, Secretary of the Organizing Committee.
