THE STATUS OF *CALOPTERYX OKINAWA-NA* MATSUMURA, 1931 (ZYGOPTERA: CALOPTERYGIDAE)

In his "6000 illustrated insects of Japan-Empire", S. MATSUMURA (1931, p. 1454) described and illustrated Calopteryx okinawana Mats. as a new species from Okinawa, Japan.

This is conspecific with Matrona basilaris japonica Foerster, 1897. However, as far as I know, this synonymy has not been presented in any publication. Consequently, in their catalogues, C.A. BRIDGES (1994) and H. STEIN-MANN (1997) list okinawana as a good species in Calopteryx, though the former hesitantly so, with a question mark after the genus name.

Thus: Matrona basilaris japonica Foerster, 1897 Calopteryx okinawana Matsumura, 1931, syn. nov.
