As readers will surely have noticed, the input of NOTULAE has been rather meagre of late. We very much hope this will improve in future, otherwise it will be difficult to produce even a single issue each year.

As well as records of general interest and field and laboratory notes, we welcome short articles in any field of odonatology (incl. ethno-odonatology, history of odonatology, bibliography, etc.). Submissions should be in one of the five languages we can accept – English, French, German, Italian and Spanish. If the submission is not in English, it should be accompanied by an English translation of its title and a brief English abstract is required for all papers. Authors are requested to send their full postal address (not just the e-mail one!) with each submission.

Already published NOTULAE should be used as examples of style, lay-out, and the way references are cited. We also request authors to have their text checked for good use of language by a native speaker BEFORE sending it to us.

Manuscript should be sent either by airmail (in which case an IBM-compatible diskette should accompany the hard copy, preferably using any version of Microsoft Word) or as an e-mail attachment.
