


CLAUSILIIDAE

- *Castelliana*. New subgenus of *Acrotoma* described by A.N. Suvorov (2002, Ruthenica, 12 (2): 161-166) from western Transcaucasia.
- *Acrotoma (Acrotoma) gegika*, *A. (Castelliana) tunievi* and *A. (C.) juliae*. Described by A.N. Suvorov (Ruthenica, 12 (2): 161-166) from NW Caucasus (Abkhazian Republic, Krasnodar Territory and Abkhazian Republic, respectively).
- *Serratoplicata*. New subgenus of *Quadruplicata* described by R.V. Egorov (2002, Treasure of Russian Shells, 5 (2): 1-77) from the western Caucasus.

HYDROBIIDAE

- *Salenthydobia ferrerii* new genus, new species. Described by T. Wilke (2003, Zoological Journal of the Linnean Society, 137 (2): 319-336) from Salentina Peninsula, Lecce Province, Italy.
- *Graziana quadrifoglio*. Described by M. Haase (2003, Journal of Molluscan Studies, 69 (2): 107-112) from southern Ticino, Switzerland.

HYGROMIIDAE

- *Salvinia*. New subgenus of *Canariella* described by M.R. Alonso, M. Ibáñez & C.E. Ponte-Lira (2003, The Veliger, 46 (1): 69-76) from the mid-Atlantic Canary Islands.

Newly described taxa (rubricated at the family level), with reference to the publications in which they were introduced. Ordered per family, families sorted alphabetically.

- *Canariella (Salvinia) tenuicostulata*, *C. (S.) tillieri* and *C. (S.) squamata*. Described by M.R. Alonso, M. Ibáñez & C.E. Ponte-Lira (2003, The Veliger, 46 (1): 69-76) from the mid-Atlantic Canary Islands (La Gomera, La Palma and La Gomera, respectively).
- *Gara*. New subgenus of *Canariella* described by M. Ibáñez, M.R. Alonso & C.E. Ponte-Lira (2002, American Malacological Bulletin, 17 (1-2): 85-90) from the mid-Atlantic Canary Islands.
- *Canariella (Gara) ronceroi* and *C. (G.) bimbachensis*. Described by M. Ibáñez, M.R. Alonso & C.E. Ponte-Lira (2002, American Malacological Bulletin, 17 (1-2): 85-90) from the mid-Atlantic Canary Islands (La Gomera and El Hierro, respectively).

LYMNAEIDAE

- *Catascozia*. New genus described by C. Meier-Brook & M.D. Bargues (2002, Folia Malacologica, 10 (2): 83-84) for North American and European taxa (type species: *Limnaea catascopium* Say, 1817).

PACHYCHILIDAE

- *Tylomelania bakara*, *T. kruimeli* and *T. helmuti*. Described by T. von Rintelen & M. Glaubrecht (2003, Journal of Molluscan Studies, 69 (1): 3-17) from the Malili Lake system, Sulawesi, Indonesia.

POMATIIDAE

- *Cyclotopsis josephinae*, *C. orchidae* and *C. tsaratanae*. Described by K.C. Emberton (2003, The Veliger, 46 (1): 60-68) from northern Madagascar.

POMATIOPSIDAE

- *Tricula hortensis*. Described by S.W. Attwood, D.S. Brown, X.H. Meng & V.R. Southgate (2003, Systematics and Biodiversity, 1 (1): 109-116) from Mianzhu County, Sichuan Province, China.

PUPILLIDAE

- *Boysidia chiangmaiensis*. Described by S. Panha & J.B. Burch (2002, Malacological Review, 31/32 (2): 117-122) from the Dao Wildlife Sanctuary, Chiang Mai Province, northern Thailand.


- *Anthroapiculus pendulus* (new genus, new species) and *Montapiculus proboscidea* new genus, new species. Described by S. Panha & J.B. Burch (2002, Malacological Review, 31/32 (2): 143-153) from Thailand (Tak Province and Nakornsa-wan Province, respectively).

SPHINCTEROCHILIDAE

- *Asensidea asensi* (new genus, new species). Described by S. Calzada (2002, Bulletin de la Société d'Histoire Naturelle de Toulouse, 138 : 51-54) from the Vallesian beds (Miocene) of Olocau del Rey, Teruel Province, NE Spain.

STREPTAXIDAE

- *Discartemon khaosokensis*. Described by S. Panha & J.B. Burch (2002, Malacological Review, 31/32 (1): 25-26) from southern Thailand.
- *Sinoennea (Sinoennea) prima*. Described by S. Panha & J.B. Burch (2002, Malacological Review, 31/32 (2): 117-122) from Doi-chiang Dao Wildlife Sancturay, Chian Mai Province, northern Thailand.
- *Gulella salpinx*. Described by D.G. Herbert (2002, African Invertebrates, 43: 125-138) from Mzimkulu River, Marble Delta, KwaZulu-Natal.
