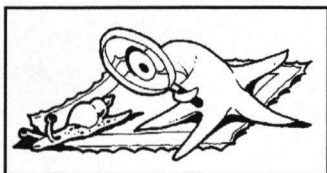


WEEKDIEREN OP POSTZEGELS MOLLUSCS ON STAMPS
