## On the status of Heteroruga Coen, 1925 (Bivalvia: Donacidae)

Heteroruga Coen, 1925 (Bivalvia: Donacidae), type species Donax exaratus Krauss, 1848, is a junior synonym of Grammatodonax Dall, 1900.

Key words: Bivalvia, Donacidae, synonymy, South Africa.

In 1925 Coen (1925: 45) introduced a new subgenus, *Heteroruga*, for *Donax exaratus* Krauss, 1848. Although his paper is listed in the Zoological Record (Mollusca) for the year 1926 (Preston, 1927), the sub-generic name is not mentioned in the systematic part. This is probably the reason why it has been overlooked by Thiele (1934) and more recently also by both Vokes (1980) and Vaught (1989).

Donax exaratus, a junior synonym of Donax madagascariensis Wood, 1828 (fide Barnard, 1974: 774), is a South African species characterized by a sculpture consisting of numerous raised oblique ridges. D. madagascariensis is the type species of Grammatodonax Dall, 1900. Therefore, Heteroruga Coen, 1925, has to be considered a junior synonym of Grammatodonax.
